Under the guidance of the Inspection Manager, the Inspector performs inspections using non-destructive examination (NDE) techniques using methods such as visual and magnetic particle testing. The Inspector travels to customer locations in Regina and the surrounding area as well as throughout the province. On-the-job training is provided for the role as well as paid training for NDE courses and exams required for certifications.

- Conduct structural inspections and tests on equipment and components
- Perform non-destructive testing (NDT) in accordance with CSA W178.2 and CGSB standards
